Important Information re: Tuition and Tax Receipts

To facilitate our accounting program's end-of-year update, TUITION FEES dated January 1st will be taken out on January 19, 2024.

As we approach the end of 2021, preparation is being done for tuition tax receipts. Before the end of February, families will receive a receipt for the portion of tuition which is deemed a tax credit. Calculations to determine amount eligible for tuition tax receipts are very complex. Each year, the school is audited, and based on the financial statements, our auditors calculate the religious and secular cost of education.

This amount is claimed as a charitable donation.

If you have fees in arrears, it is in your best interest to bring your account up to date before the end of December to maximize your tax receipt.
